Happy Mother's Day

In the U.S. Mothers' Day is a holiday celebrated on the second Sunday in May. It is a day when children honor their mothers with cards, gifts, and flowers. The first observance was in Philadelphia in 1907.

Although it wasn't celebrated across the U.S. until 1908, there were days honoring mothers even in the days of ancient Greece.



Later, in the 1600's, in England there was an annual observance called "Mothering Sunday." It was celebrated during Lent, on the fourth Sunday. On Mothering Sunday, the servants, who generally lived with their employers, were encouraged to return home and honor their mothers. It was traditional for them to bring a special cake along to celebrate the occasion.

In the U.S., in 1908 Ana Jarvis, from Grafton, West Virginia, began a campaign to establish a national Mother's Day. Jarvis persuaded her mother's church in Grafton, West Virginia to celebrate Mother's Day on the anniversary of her mother's death. A memorial service was held there on May 10, 1908 and in Philadelphia the following year where Jarvis moved.

Jarvis and others began a letter-writing campaign to ministers, businessmen, and politicians in their quest to establish a national Mother's Day. They were successful. President Woodrow Wilson, in 1914, made the official announcement proclaiming Mother's Day a national observance that was to be held each year on the 2nd Sunday of May.

Many other countries of the world celebrate their own Mother's Day at different times throughout the year. Denmark, Finland, Italy, Turkey, Australia, and Belgium celebrate Mother's Day on the second Sunday in May, as in the U.S.

Trivia about Mothers...

- ♥ There are 84 million mom's in the U.S.
- ♥ The youngest mother on record was Lina Medina, who delivered a 6½-pound boy by cesarean section in Lima, Peru in 1939, at the age of 5 years and 7 months.
- ♥ The odds of a woman delivering twins is 1-in-33. Her odds of having triplets is approximately 1-in-539.
- ♥ August is the most popular month in which to have a baby.
- ♥ Kentucky has the highest percentage of women who are mothers at 67%. The national average is 57%.
- ♥ About 4 million women will have babies this year.
- ♥ The median age of a woman giving birth for the first time in the U.S. is 24.8.
- ♥ Daughters keep in closer contact with their mothers than do sons. (*Pew Research*)
- ♥ There are more phone calls made on Mother's Day than on any other day of the year. (*Pew Research*)
- ♥ The number of people calling their moms on Mother's Day has declined in recent years due to e-mail and other electronic means of communication.
- ♥ While nearly 80 percent of Americans will buy a card for mom this year, 83 percent of the cards will be purchased by daughters. (*American Greetings*)
- ♥ Mother's Day is the third-largest card-sending holiday.
- ♥ Mother's Day is the busiest day of the year for restaurants.

Power Moving Faith

Faith is one of the most powerful forces on earth. With it we can move mountains, receive remarkable answers to prayer, and experience the impossible. "Nothing is impossible to him that believes.

Jesus gave us an important lesson about the power of faith (Mark 11:12-24).¹² And on the morrow, when they were come from Bethany, he was hungry:¹³ And seeing a fig tree afar off having leaves, he came, if haply he might find any thing thereon: and when he came to it, he found nothing but leaves; for the time of figs was not yet.¹⁴ And Jesus answered and said unto it, No man eat fruit of thee hereafter for ever. And his disciples heard it.¹⁵ And they come to Jerusalem: and Jesus went into the temple, and began to cast out them that sold and bought in the temple, and overthrew the tables of the moneychangers, and the seats of them that sold doves;¹⁶ And would not suffer that any man should carry any vessel through the temple.¹⁷ And he taught, saying unto them, Is it not written, My house shall be called of all nations the house of prayer? but ye have made it a den of thieves.¹⁸ And the scribes and chief priests heard it, and sought how they might destroy him: for they feared him, because all the people was astonished at his doctrine.¹⁹ And when even was come, he went out of the city.²⁰ And in the morning, as they passed by, they saw the fig tree dried up from the roots.²¹ And Peter calling to remembrance saith unto him, Master, behold, the fig tree which thou cursedst is withered away.²² And Jesus answering saith unto them, Have faith in God.²³ For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith.²⁴ Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye

desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them.

Do You Have Faith Or Not

If you do not have faith then you must have doubt. If you don't have the positive, you must have the negative. The faith we should have is the "faith of God that moves mountains."

And how does this faith work? Jesus explained how: "...whosoever... shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith".

Don't forgot an important component of faith is belief and speaking. Jesus said that you must believe and speak the words. Believing and speaking go together. Many people are speaking without believing, and therefore are not getting any positive results.

Common Mistake

Another common mistake people make is that they are praying instead of speaking. There are times to pray about problems and times to speak to the problems. Do you remember when Moses was told to speak to the rock but he struck it. It cost him the ability to live within the land flowing with milk and honey.

Jesus clearly told us that we must speak to the obstacle, and that if we have faith, the obstacle (mulberry tree) will obey us (Luke 17:6). Let us not pervert His words!

Expect It To Be Done

After Jesus had cursed the fig tree and as He walked by it the next day He did not look at the tree to see if its appearance was any different than the previous day. If we had cursed the tree and the next day passed by that same tree, would we have looked at it to see if there was a noticeable change?

Most of us would have to answer the same way. We would have had to look. But Jesus is different. He never goes by what He sees. He was not even looking to see if the tree's appearance had altered. NO! He spoke to the tree and then went on His way, knowing that it would have to obey His faith-filled words.

Don't focus your eyes on your difficulty. Don't be checking up to see if your words are working. Be confident that your words of faith must work... they must
