The "harvest" needs workers (servants):

Read

Matthew 25:31-46

Servant: one that serves others; a public servant.; *especially:* one that performs duties about the person or home of a master or personal employer.

Matthew's scripture displays a theme or call to humbleness-servant hood.

Matthew 20:24-28

And when the ten heard it, they were moved with indignation against the two brethren. ²⁵ But Jesus called them unto him, and said, "You know

that the princes of the Gentiles exercise dominion over them, and they that are great exercise authority upon them. ²⁶ But it shall not be so among you, but whosoever will be great among you, let him be your minister, ²⁷ and whoever will be chief among you, let him be your servant:

²⁸ Even as the Son of Man came not to be ministered unto, but to minister, and to give his life a ransom for many.

On whose "authority" will we serve? Scripture talks about the goats and the sheep. Goats are very independent and stubborn

by nature and will eat anything.



Sheep rely on the Shepherd. They are very dependant by nature. They eat only grass because that is nourishing to them.

²"So when you give to the needy, do not announce it with trumpets, as the hypocrites do in the synagogues and on the streets, to be honored by men. There are five parts of me (and probably) you.

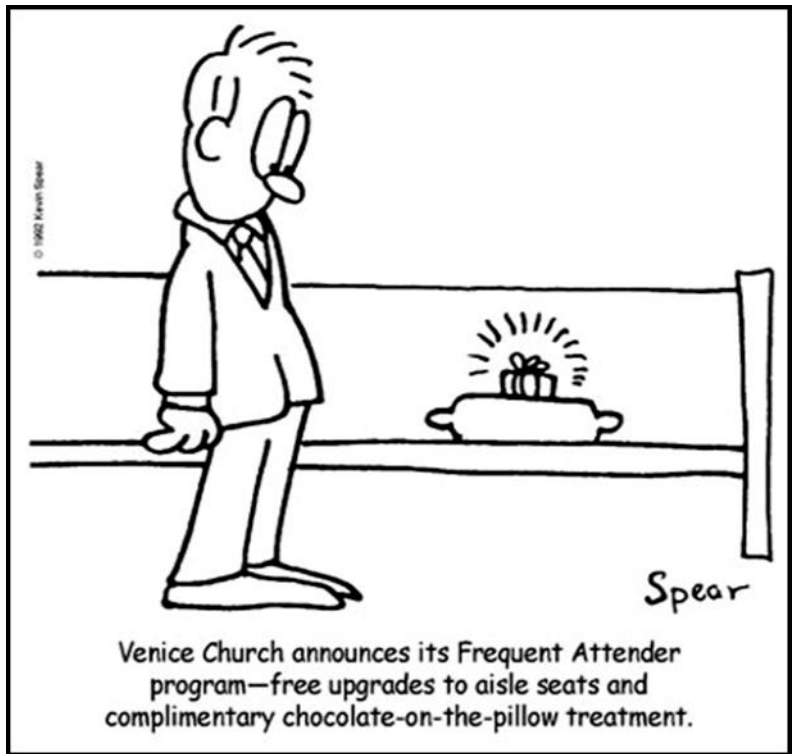
1. Part of myself that I know and like and let my friends see -

Unbreakable?

Text: 2 Corinthians 4:7-12

Topic: Jars of clay in a crash-bang world

We demonstrate the power of Christ by enduring hardship.

Keywords: Attitude; Call; Calling; Christ like; Circumstances & faith; Comfort; Compassion; Courage; Defeat; Faith & Feelings; Faithfulness and goodness of God; Growth; Holy Spirit; Hope; Ministry; Outreach; Overcoming; Patience; Victory

Paul wrote 2 Corinthians after surviving more than a few train wrecks in his life, and it speaks about the unbreakable faith that sustains us through dangerous times.

Vs 7: We have these jars of clay to show that this all-surpassing power is from God and not from us.

Vs. 8: Many times we feel hard pressed on every side; but we are not crushed; perplexed, but not despaired.

Vs. 9: Persecuted, but never abandoned; struck down, but not destroyed.

Vs. 10: We carry around in our body the death of Jesus, so that the life of Jesus may also be revealed in us.

Vs. 11: For when we are alive we are being given over to death for Jesus' sake.

Vs. 12: So if death is at work in us, then life is at work in you.

Paul continues his defense of himself and his ministry. He acknowledges that he does not lose heart because he is renewed every day by the knowledge that affliction is light and temporary compared to the eternal weight of glory that awaits him, and a very important truth, Paul keeps his focus on things which are unseen but eternal.

If the Gospel seems veiled, it is only to those whom satan has blinded so they might not see the light of the gospel. Do our trials "blind" us to the light of the gospel or do we see God's power in us?



"Yet, O Lord, Thou art our Father; we are the clay, and Thou art our potter; we are all the work of Thy hand" (Isaiah 64:8 RSV) and "The spirit of God has made me, and the breath of the Almighty gives me life ... I too was formed from a piece of clay." (Job 33:4,6 RSV)
