The New Deal

President Roosevelt was elected in November 1932, to the first of four terms. By March there were thirteen million (13,000,000) people unemployed, and almost every bank was closed. The country was in a mess and we needed help. We needed a new deal.

This country was in a great depression!

In President Roosevelt's first "hundred days," he proposed, and Congress enacted, a sweeping program to bring recovery to business and agriculture, relief to the unemployed and to those in danger of losing farms and homes, by establishment of the Tennessee Valley Authority, WPA and the CCC.

Tennessee Valley Authority and the WPA were for older men
AND
The CCC that was designed for youth.

The CCC paid \$1.00 a day or \$30.00 a month where \$25.00 went back to their family that boosted the economy conductions across the nation. Thousands of young me lived in camps as if they were in the army. The program had great public support. Young men flocked to enroll.

With only shovels, hoes, rakes, and other hand tools, they brought to life more than 800 state parks. They learned how to get along with others, work together as a team, and have respect for each other.

Then: Japanese attacked Pearl Harbor on December 7, 1941, which brought us into WWII. Without anyone knowing it, the US had between 2.5 to 3 million men army ready for battle through the WPA and the CCC.

Without the depression or these programs the US would not have been ready for such a battle.

What are we doing today that will train us for the job tomorrow?

Godly People

If you talk to Christians within the membership of a Church you will hear so many of them verbally declare that many of their members are Godly people. But, if the truth was known, many of these people would not stand up to the test if someone put them under a microscope. Matter of fact, many would affirm themselves that they are not Godly, but they are striving to be the person God wants them to be day in and day out. We know our Lord knows our inner being. People look at our good works and judge us accordingly. We have the tendency to judge people comparing them to others in the same situations when we should be comparing ourselves to Christ.

So who do we raise up as a Godly Person, our friends, pastor, or that person that was there in our time of need? What about you? Are you a person with your heart and mind in the world and your feet in the church? Or, are you the kind that seeks to do God's will as revealed in Scripture? Whichever one you are, the Bible tells us to examine ourselves to see if we are in the faith. Have we examined our beliefs, our actions, our motives and compared them to scripture to see what kind of a person we are? Are we submitting our life to God or God to our life?

Who is a Godly person? Is a person a Godly person if they have these distinctions?

They believe the Holy Scriptures to be the written Word of God, infallible, and inspired by God!

There is one God, existing in three persons; Father, Son, and Holy Spirit; Coequal and Eternal.

That man was created in the image of God; but he sinned and thereby brought on himself the curse of physical death and spiritual death, which is eternal separation from God. All men since Adam are born with a sinful nature, and their only hope is to be regenerated (born again), through Jesus, the Son.

That salvation has been provided by grace (undeserved) through the sacrifice of God's Son, the Lord Jesus Christ, because He died in our place on the cross.

That Jesus Christ is the only begotten Son of the Father conceived of the Holy Ghost, and born of the Virgin Mary.

That Jesus was crucified, buried, and arose from the dead. That He ascended into heaven and is today at the right hand of the Father as the Intercessor.

That all have sinned and come short of the glory of God and that repentance is commanded from God for all and necessary for forgiveness of sins.

That justification, regeneration, and the new birth are bought by faith in the blood of Jesus Christ.

That Holiness is God's standard of living for His people.

Believe in baptism with the Holy Ghost.

Believe in water baptism by immersion, and all who repent should be baptized in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost.

Believe in the bodily Resurrection; eternal life for the righteous, and eternal punishment for the wicked.

Should they also be:

A Person of Purity ... keep your mind, body and soul faithful to God!

Discipline of Relationships ... put some holy sweat into your relationships!

A Person of Like Mind of Christ ... keep your mind on whatever is true, whatever is honorable, whatever is just, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is commendable, if there is any excellence, if there is anything worthy of praise, think about these things.

Discipline of Devotion ... have a desire to read, meditate and respond to God's Word!

A Person of Integrity ... having a character of God, a clear conscience, deep intimacy with God!

Bridle Tongue Person ... If anyone thinks he is godly and does not bridle his tongue but deceives his heart, this person's religion is worthless.

A Person that will not conform to this World ... And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.

A Called Person ... our vocation is a divine calling and thus be liberated to do it for the glory of God.

A Person That Manifest Our Lord ... tell people how wonderful our Lord is!

A Person of Faith ... The just shall live by faith and without faith it is impossible to please God!

A Person That is Committed to God's Church ... commit themselves wholeheartedly to a Church. There participation should include financial support, but it should also include giving of their time, talents, expertise, and creativity to the glory of God!

A Giver ... By giving from a heart overflowing with God's grace, like the believers in Macedonia who "gave themselves first to the Lord!"—"God loves a cheerful giver!"

A Obedient Person ... **Jesus said, "If ye love me, keep my commandments."**

A Person That Prays, Loves, Blesses ... We are to love your enemies, bless them that curse you, do good to them that hate you, and pray for them which despitefully use you, and persecute you;

A Follower of Christ ... Jesus said that those whom He knows hear His voice and follow Him! No man can serve two masters: for either he will hate the one, and love the other; or else he will hold to the one, and despise the other!

A Person With Compassion ... When Jesus saw the multitudes, he was moved with compassion on them, because they fainted, and were scattered abroad, as sheep having no shepherd.

Matthew 10:6-10 says: 6. But go rather to the lost sheep of the house of Israel. 7. And as ye go, preach, saying, The kingdom of heaven is at hand. 8. Heal the sick, cleanse the lepers, raise the dead, cast out devils: freely ye have received, freely give. 9. Provide neither gold, nor silver, nor brass in your purses, 10. Nor scrip for your journey, neither two coats, neither shoes, nor yet staves: for the workman is worthy of his meat.

So who among us would say they are Godly? Who would stand on a pedestal and never fall off? I pray that we all will live every day as if it was our last day on this earth. May we never compare ourselves to others, but to Christ and I pray that we all will strive to be like the people listed above and so much more. Live for God's glory! Do not be ashamed of the gospel! Our Lord will equip us to do His Will, but remember the Bible says for every one that exalteth himself shall be abased; and he that humbleth himself shall be exalted.

I believe that we are living in the time that was foretold, the "Time of the End." May our Lord find us busy at His return, doing His work!

Or else, while the other is yet a great way off, he sendeth an ambassador, and desireth conditions of peace. 33. So likewise, whosoever he be of you that forsaketh not all that he hath, he cannot be my disciple. 34. Salt is good: but if the salt have lost his savour, wherewith shall it be seasoned? 35. It is neither fit for the land, nor yet for the dunghill; but men cast it out. He that hath ears to hear, let him hear.*

Have we counted the cost? Can we call ourselves our Lord's disciples? Do we have faith, but not works? Faith without works is dead!
