

Friends and Partners:

Our Lord has blessed Love And Compassion Ministries in so many ways. We have more than 35 wonderful volunteers serving our Lord within this ministry. For more than 17 years we have proclaimed the love of Christ and have taught the Gospel of Salvation, knowing that more important than their physical needs being met, is the need of receiving Christ as their Savior.

In May we provided gas for 3 people to get to work. We gave out 424 batteries, 6 tarps, 2 tents, 32 flashlights, 42 cans of bug spray, 20 solar bike taillights and 9 headlights. We transported one man to a drug program on the east coast, got one person a picture ID and fed 8 people a good meal. We also provided 4 packages of cookies and 2 gallons of milk to the youth.

We purchased a bus ticket for one lady to get home in Hastings, Florida, one man to get to San Diego, California and another from Fort Lauderdale to Port Charlotte. We gave out 32 county one day bus passes. We also taught a Bible study every week at a veteran's club at Charlotte County Corrections, Lee County Stockade, the Ortiz Work Camp and at the Crossroads facility for troubled youth.

We also serve lunch and dinner to the youth at Crossroads once a month. We also helped a lady with two children with a broken car window and paid a utility bill for another lady.

All of these items cost more than \$890.00. That was for one month. These people needed us to be there in their time of need.

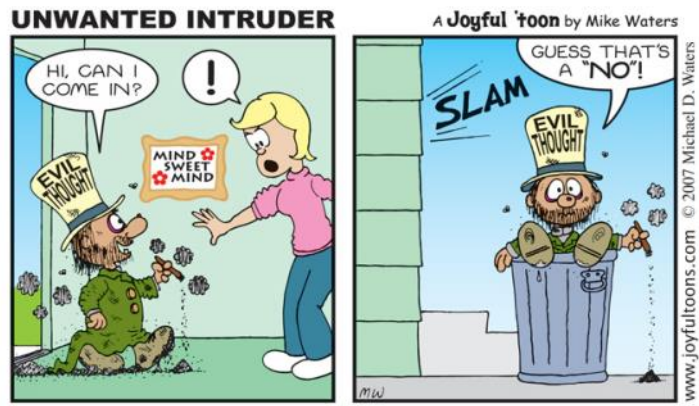
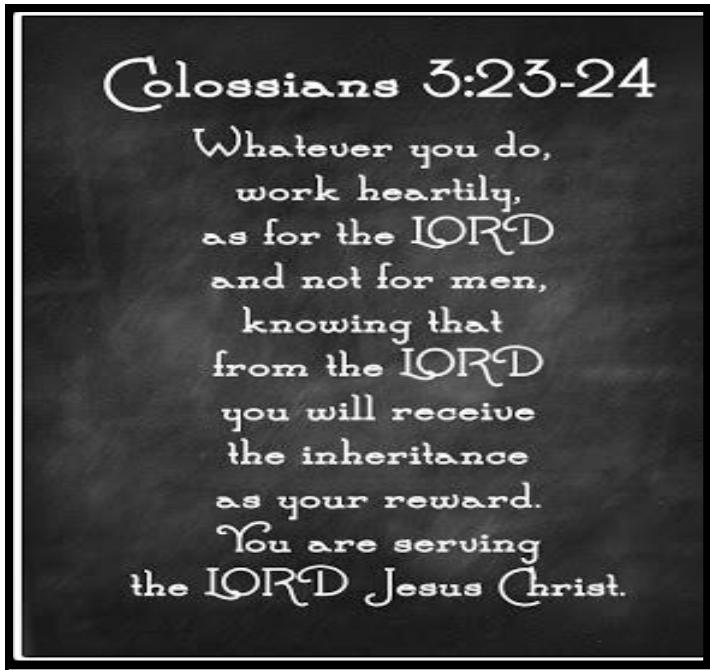
